TN grew 11.19% despite fund crunch, says Stalin

Express News Service @Chennai. TAMIL NADU has achieved double-digit economic growth despite grappling with the twin challenges of the pandemic, and financial constraints imposed by the union government, Chief Minister M K Stalin said on Saturday.

Responding to queries from the public through the Makkaludal Stalin app, the chief minister said, “When we assumed office, the state was reeling under the impact of Covid-19, a financial crunch, and the BJP-led Union government’s denial of funds due to us. Yet, we registered 11.19% growth — nearly double the rate under the AIADMK regime.”

Stalin noted that between 2011 and 2016, TN’s average economic growth was 6.7%, which slipped further to 5.2% between 2016 and 2021. In contrast, his government achieved an average growth rate of 8.9% over the last four years.

“While Karnataka recorded 7.9% and Maharashtra 8.2% after Covid, TN reached 11.19%. This reflects our efficiency,” he said.

Pointing to the state’s progress in exports, Stalin said Tamil Nadu had advanced from third to first place in the Export Preparedness Index. Exports, which stood at \$26 billion prior to 2021, had doubled to \$52 billion, while employment in the manufacturing sector had risen from 35 lakh to 73 lakh.

“What the AIADMK could not achieve in 10 years, we delivered in four. And we will beat our own record,” he asserted.

On being asked about new welfare measures, Stalin likened the state’s journey to that of a child learning to walk. “The progress we have made in 100 years is like a child learning to walk. Now we must compete globally and run. This will continue under Dravidian Model 2.0,” he said.

CM: German investors ready to invest in TN

Stalin: TN's GSDP Reflects Holistic Growth. Chief Minister M.K. Stalin said on Saturday that German investors were ready to invest in Tamil Nadu, and the state was aiming to leverage this opportunity to ensure its development.

In response to criticism regarding his foreign visits, Stalin released videos on X as part of the 'Ungali Oruvan' series, addressing various questions submitted through the 'Makkaludal Stalin' app.

Regarding his recent foreign tour, Germany and UK, Stalin said the delegation had met investors in Germany, showcasing the state's infrastructure and skilled workforce.

He said, “The appreciation for Tamil Nadu for employment opportunities, more so, spoke highly of development that has been achieved and the importance given to all sectors. They are ready to invest in various sectors in Tamil Nadu and support this change and development to the next level.”

He noted that state govt has been implementing visionary plans.

In a veiled criticism of TVK cadres and supporters, Stalin said people in Germany and UK displayed great discipline in public places and suggested that citizens should emulate this behaviour.

On Tamil Nadu achieving double-digit growth, Stalin said the Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) reflects the state's comprehensive growth, including multi-sectoral advancement, employment, per capita income, standard of living, and purchasing power.

Stalin emphasized the significance of growth figures, stating, “When DMK assumed office, the Covid pandemic was at its peak and despite the economic slowdown, the state achieved 11.19% growth with an average of 8.9% in four years. This is double the growth rate when compared to that during previous AIADMK regime from 2011 to 2016, when growth rate was 6.7% and from 2016 to 2021, when growth rate was 5.2%.”

Chief Minister M.K. Stalin said on Saturday that the DMK government had achieved more in the last four years than the AIADMK did in the 10 years between 2011 and 2021, when the party was in power.

Mr. Stalin, while answering questions under the 'Ungali Oruvan' (One Among You) initiative on Saturday, said in his video address that during his meetings with investors in Germany, a detailed presentation was made showcasing Tamil Nadu's infrastructure development, the State's talent pool, and initiatives in skill development.

He said the investors appreciated the steps taken by the Tamil Nadu government, particularly in providing the highest employment opportunities for women in India. The DMK government's balanced approach, ensuring development across all districts and sectors, was also acknowledged.

Investors across several fields have shown keen interest. The Dravidian model government wishes to take this forward to the next stage by implementing long-term strategies,” the Chief Minister said.

“In both Germany and London, I met many students from Tamil Nadu who said they had benefited from the reservation policy. Many of them were first-generation graduates in their families, who had come abroad for studies and benefited from the scheme of tuition fee waiver for first-generation graduates introduced by Kalaignar (former Chief Minister M. Karunanidhi),” he said.

Mr. Stalin said Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) was a key indicator reflecting growth across sectors such as industry, employment, generation per capita income, quality of life, education, health care, infrastructure, and law and order.

When the DMK came to power, the COVID-19 pandemic was at its peak, and the State was under severe financial distress. Despite the failure of the BJP government at the Centre to provide Tamil Nadu its due share of funds, we achieved an economic growth rate of 11.19%, which is double than that of the previous AIADMK government,” the Chief Minister said.

Mr. Stalin pointed out that during the AIADMK government's tenure from 2011 to 2016, the average growth rate was 6.7%, which dropped to 5.2% between 2016 and 2021. In comparison, the DMK government has recorded an average growth rate of 8.9% over the past four years.

“The BJP government at the Centre is targeting the DMK because we oppose delimitation, National Eligibility cum Entrance Test, Special Intensive Revision of electoral rolls, and demand the release of Samagra Shiksha funds and the Keeladi report. Anyone can speak against the BJP, but only the DMK has the experience, strength, and ideology to challenge it,” he added.
