The Chief Minister, who interacted with around 10,000 representatives of local bodies during a webinar, dedicated a major portion of his speech to clean drinking water.

Stalin said water security was an important issue that required immediate attention. "There is a saying, 'spending money like water, but in reality we have to use water as if it were gold',"

He said, "We are not receiving adequate rainfall at the right time. Climate change is one of the reasons for this. We must create awareness among the public about this issue."
